Finding the strength to play their fourth game in four consecutive days, the Brampton A's defeated the Windsor Express 105-103 on Monday night at the Powerade Centre. Cedric Moodie's 19 points made him one of a half-dozen A's that scored in double figures; while Flenard Whitfield garnered a double-double of 18 points and 12 team-high rebounds. Cavell Johnson had a pair of blocked shots to go with his 13 points.

On Thursday night, based on the strength of an amazing 46-27 third quarter run, the Brampton A's trounced Ottawa 124-87 at the Powerade Centre. Cavell Johnson cranked out 25 team-high points, constructed from 12-for-17 shooting from the floor. Seven different A's scored in double figures, including Scottie Haralson and Evaldas Zabas (15 pts apiece).

The A's then took their second Maritime trip of the season, as they visited Saint John on Friday night. Cavell Johnson, playing against his former team, powered a team-high 24 points and 2 blocked shots as Brampton continued their winning streak, 107-102 over the Mill Rats. Kevin Francis, another former Mill Rat, led the A's in rebounds with 11. Evaldas Zabas added 20 points, while Jameson Tipping loaded 18 points onto the scoreboard.

Finally, in what has to be the Game of the Week, the A's took a 101-100 road victory over the Island Storm, when Cedric Moodie hit a last-second 3-pointer to clinch the victory. Moodie finished with 18 points, while Cavell Johnson added 21 to lead the team once again in scoring.

It's time for the Storm to make their first Ontario road trip, which began Wednesday in Windsor. But even with Greg Plummer powering 22 points, the Storm lost a close 90-86 game to the Express. Antonio Ballard's 14 rebounds matched up with his 16 points for a double-double; while Shawn Vanzant added 19 points to the game totals.

The Storm's struggles continued on Friday night, as they dropped a 113-99 loss to the Ottawa SkyHawks. Antonio Ballard's team-high 28 points included going 10-for-13 from the free throw line; Greg Plummer added 21 points of his own for the Storm. Steve Tcheingang's 13 points included eight rebounds.
