But because a snowstorm forced a postponement of the Brampton-Halifax game last week, that contest was rescheduled for Monday, with the London-at-Brampton game to be made up at a later date. The change did the A's well; as six different A's scored in double figures in Brampton's 107-92 triumph over the Rainmen. Scottie Haralson came off the bench to score 20 points, while Cedric Moodie added 16 points, 6 assists and 4 steals.</p> <p>But on Sunday, the A's felt like Z's in a 115-108 loss on the road to the Ottawa SkyHawks. Cavell Johnson almost had a double-double, scoring 22 points and grabbing 9 rebounds. Cedric Moodie scored 18 points, while Jameson Tipping and Scottie Haralson each garnered 14 points for Brampton.</p>

Jajuan Cooley had 10 points, 6 assists and 3 steals. Halifax was a woeful 13-for-20 from the free throw line in the game.</p> <p>Next up for the Rainmen was a Boxing Day matchup on the road in Prince Edward Island. The afternoon contest saw Halifax fall 106-98, even with 15 points from Jajuan Cooley, 14 points from Olumuyiwa Famutimi, and an 11-point, 11-board double-double from Jason Williams.</p> <p>Halifax's four-game losing streak died on Friday night, as the Rainmen upset the Saint John Mill Rats 98-91 on the strength of balanced shooting. George Goode started off with 15 points, Jason Williams added 14, and Raven Barber and Tim Parham had 13 points apiece; Parham also grabbed 11 rebounds and had four blocked shots.</p> <p>But on Sunday, in a rematch from Friday night's victory, the Rainmen were trampled 121-107 by the Saint John Mill Rats at the MetroCentre. Jason Williams garnered 26 points and 8 rebounds, leading the Rainmen in scoring and boards. Olumuyiwa Famutimi also had 8 rebounds, while Jajuan Cooley had four steals in the game.</p>

Semaj Inge's 25 team-high points were augmented by him going 16-for-18 from the free throw line. Antonio Ballard had a double-double of 20 points and 14 rebounds, while Al Stewart had 14 points, 5 assists and 4 steals.</p> <p>The Storm's winning streak, unfortunately, ended on Friday night against the cellar-dwelling Moncton Miracles. Even with Greg Plummer putting 20 points on the scoreboard, the Storm lost on the road, 104-97. Antonio Ballard (16 pts, 11 rebs) and Jeremy Williams (15 pts) were the only other Islanders to score in double figures that night.</p> <p>A Saturday evening rematch with Moncton turned into another Storm loss, this time by a 96-83 tally. Antonio Ballard had a double-double of 18 points and 11 rebounds, leading the Storm in both categories. Al Stewart garnered 14 points, while Ashton Graham and Dwayne Smith came off the bench to score 12 and 10 points, respectively.</p>

After the Christmas break, London traveled to the Hershey Centre to take another victory from the Mississauga Power, 117-92. In the triumph, Garrett Williamson and Tony Bennett lit up the London scoreboard with 25 and 23 points, respectively. Marvin Phillips had 9 rebounds to go with his 15 points; Elvin Mims blocked two shots.

The Lightning added another win against the Power on Sunday afternoon, as over 3,500 people crammed into the Budweiser Gardens to watch Micheal Ray Richardson's crew defeat Mississauga 99-76. Marvin Phillips was the lead scorer for the Lightning, as he completed a 22-point, 10-rebound night. Tony Bennett also had a double-double of 13 points and 11 assists.

The Mississauga Power are still trying to claw their way out of the NBL's Central Division basement. Unfortunately for coach David Joseph's crew, the Power took another loss, 117-92, at the hands of the London Lightning. The top scorer for the Power was Morgan Lewis, who scored 18 points; Alex Johnson had 11 assists to go with his 11 points; Shamus Ferguson was the top rebounder with 8 boards.

Next at the Hershey Centre came the Ottawa SkyHawks, and despite 20 points from Nick Okorie and 19 from Morgan Lewis, the Power lost another game, this time by the score of 100-89. Lewis also led the team in rebounds, with 9; Alex Johnson had 7 assists. Dwight McCombs' 10 points included two blocked shots.

Mississauga's losing streak continued on Sunday, as the Power suffered their worst scoring drought of the year, falling 99-76 to the London Lightning. Dwight McCombs put 24 points – nearly one-third of the Power's total output – on the board; McCombs also pulled down 15 rebounds.

Are the Moncton Miracles turning their losing ways around? A sign came on Thursday evening, as the Miracles extended the Saint John Mill Rats to an overtime period before falling 126-116. Johnny Mayhane had 24 points, including the game-tying score in regulation. Trayvon Lathan added 23 points and 11 rebounds in the Moncton loss, while Oliver McNally dished out 15 assists.

The next evening, Moncton ended their eleven-game losing streak with a definitive 104-97 win over the Island Storm at the Moncton Coliseum. Johnny Mayhane was again the top scorer for the Miracles with 30 points; Trayvon Lathan contributed 21 points. The newly-signed Brandon Webster pulled down 10 rebounds.

The Miracles and the Storm faced each other again on Saturday night, and the results were the same – Moncton with another win, this time by a 96-83 score. Stanley Robinson put a double-double of 26 points and 11 rebounds on the scoreboard, while Johnny Mayhane added 20 points. Trayvon Lathan and a returning Sylvania Watkins scored 14 points apiece.

The Ottawa SkyHawks need to turn their season around, but a rough 102-87 loss to the Windsor Express didn't help. Ryan Anderson was the top scorer for Ottawa with 31 points; while Jermaine Johnson (16 rebs, 15 pts) and Eric Kibi (11 rebs, 10 pts) had double-doubles for the SkyHawks. Tirrell Baines had five blocked shots in the loss.

The SkyHawks returned to the victory column on Saturday, as they defeated the Mississauga Power 100-89 on the road. Jermaine Johnson scored 20 points to lead Ottawa in victory; Johnson was one of six players from the Capital City crew to score in double figures. Jerice Crouch had 8 assists in the Ottawa win.

On Thursday, the Saint John Mill Rats needed to keep winning to stay neck-and-neck with the Island Storm atop the NBL's Central Division. But it took a 126-116 overtime victory against the Moncton Miracles to achieve this effort. Jermaine Blackburn poured in 24 team-high points, while Chris Matthews (23) and Casey Love (21) gave the Rats much-needed bench scoring. Tyrone Levett had 9 rebounds to go with his 11 points; while Doug Herring Jr. had 14 points and 4 steals.

A strong win against the Miracles did not translate into a momentum shift for the Mill Rats, as Saint John lost the next night, 98-91, to the Halifax Rainmen.
