Cedric Moodie had a powerful double-double of 33 points and 11 rebounds; he also went 11-for-16 from the floor, including ringing up a trio of 3-pointers. Evaldas Zabas added 26 points, while Steven Idlet distributed 6 assists.

The Halifax Rainmen tried to battle their way out of the NBL's Atlantic Division cellar, but a 107-95 loss at the hands of the Island Storm stunted the Rainmen's momentum. Jajuan Cooley was the top scorer for Halifax with 24 points and 4 steals; Olumuyiwa Famutimi garnered a double-double of 21 points and 10 rebounds, while Tim Parham added 15 points.

Then came a Thursday night competition at Moncton – a game that originally started in late November, but was postponed due to a city-wide power failure. When the game was suspended, Halifax led 37-36. But the Rainmen lost the lead early; and when the game ended, Halifax came up short on a 92-89 loss. George Goode and Jason Williams had 15 team-high points apiece; while Raven Barber had a 12-12 double-double (12 pts, 12 rebs).

On Friday night, the Rainmen lost to the Saint John Mill Rats 98-88, despite 16 points apiece from Jason Williams and Raven Barber. Olumuyiwa Famutimi was one rebound shy of a double-double (14 pts, 9 rebs). Jajuan Cooley's 13 points included seven assists and three steals.

Finally, the Rainmen hosted the Moncton Miracles on Saturday night at the MetroCentre. Chris Matthews, whom the Rainmen received in a trade with Saint John, scored 21 points for his new team in an 89-87 loss. George Goode (14 points, 13 rebounds) had a double-double for the Rainmen. Tim Parham also had 13 rebounds, as well as two blocked shots.

The Storm's week ended on Sunday afternoon with a 101-89 road loss to the Moncton Miracles. Antonio Ballard (19 pts) and Shawn Vanzant (17 pts) were the top scorers for the Storm, while Al Stewart finished the night with 13 points and 4 steals.

The London Lightning started 2014 off right, as they battled the Windsor Express on Wednesday afternoon at Budweiser Gardens. With nearly 3,000 fans cheering the black and gold on, the Lightning rode Tony Bennett's 22 points to a 93-82 victory. Marvin Phillips had a double-double of 21 points and 11 rebounds; he also stole the ball five times.

But in a Saturday evening road game against the Brampton A's, the Lightning fell 108-103, even with 19 points and 14 rebounds from Marvin Phillips. Phillips was one of six Lightning players to score in double figures; Darin Mency (15) and Greg Surmacz (3) also scored in double figures for London. Elvin Mims' 12 points included three blocked shots.

After the loss, the Lightning took out their frustrations on the next squad to enter Budweiser Gardens – and that team was the Ottawa SkyHawks. With eight of London's nine dressed players scoring in double figures, the Lightning took a 120-108 win in front of over 3,000 fans at Budweiser Gardens. The top scorer for the black and gold was Garrett Williamson with 23 points; Maurice Bolden and Tim Ellis had 10 rebounds apiece; Marvin Phillips blocked three shots.

The Mississauga Power's losing streak reached 7 games with a Friday night 101-91 loss to the Windsor Express. Kirk Williams Jr. led the team with 21 bench points, while Dwight McCombs achieved a double-double of 20 points / 15 rebounds, while Alex Johnson and Nick Okorie garnered 15 points apiece.

On Saturday night, the Power hosted Ottawa – only to have Mississauga lose its eighth straight game, 106-93. Nick Okorie's 18 points made him the Power's top scorer for the night; he also dished out 10 assists. Alex Johnson scored 14 bench points and distributed 11 assists. Slowly but surely, the Moncton Miracles are assembling a nice little winning streak. Their streak continued on New Year's Eve with a 100-90 road victory against the Saint John Mill Rats. While Trayvon Lathan and Johnny Mayhane each scored 18 team-high points, Stanley Robinson achieved a double-double of 15 points and 10 rebounds.

The Miracles' winning streak reached four games, as their November 21st game against Halifax, which was suspended due to a city-wide power failure, was resumed on Thursday night – and thanks to 17 points from Oliver McNally and 16 points from Stanley Robinson, the Miracles claimed a 92-89 triumph.

Make it five wins in a row, as Moncton took a Saturday evening road victory against the Halifax Rainmen, 89-87, with Johnny Mayhane acquiring 17 points for the Miracles. The game was a low-scoring affair, but Sylvania Watkins (13 pts, 2 blocks) and Travis George (12 pts, 8 rebs) also scored in double figures for Moncton.

Another win came on Sunday afternoon in front of the Miracles' loyal fans at the Moncton Coliseum. With Johnny Mayhane dropping 28 points in the bucket, Moncton defeated the Island Storm 101-89. The difference between being the #3 seed and the #4 seed in the NBL's Central Division is simple. The #4 seed would have to play the #5 seed in a one-game "play-in" postseason contest, while the winner of that game would face the #3 seed. For the Ottawa SkyHawks, they need to climb up the Central Division ladder as soon as possible. And a 106-93 triumph over the Mississauga Power helps Ottawa's postseason plans. Justin Tubbs didn't start the game, but he did snag 31 points off the bench. Eric Kibi put together a double-double of 18 rebounds and 13 points; Tirrell Baines also had a double-double of 15 points and 10 rebounds.

A New Year's Eve matchup with the Moncton Miracles brought over 2,000 fans to Harbour Station. But even with 22 points from Anthony Anderson, and a 19-point, 8-rebound night from Jermaine Blackburn, the Mill Rats were upset 100-90 by the Miracles. Casey Love came off the bench to score 18 points, while Doug Herring Jr. had 8 rebounds to go with his 11 points.

Saint John re-energized their momentum on Thursday night by defeating the Island Storm 102-94 in a battle of the top two teams in the NBL's Atlantic Division. Darren Duncan's 16 points were tops for the Motor City crew, while Quinzel Brown garnered 14 points; Kevin Loiselle and Chris Commons both pulled down 10 rebounds apiece.
