For the fourth straight game, Brent Jennings was the top scorer for the A's, notching 19 points in the loss; Jennings also had 7 rebounds and 2 blocked shots. Akeem Ellis added 17 points, while Bryson Johnson notched 13 points and 7 boards.</p> <p>The A's righted the ship on Saturday night, as Cavell Johnson's 25 team-high points spurred Brampton to a 114-111 home victory over the Mississauga Power. The Akeem Twins – Scott and Ellis – hit 15 points apiece, while returning Thomas Granado had a double-double of 13 rebounds and 11 points.</p>

On Friday night at the Scotiabank Centre, Halifax lost a close contest to the Mill Rats, 109-102, despite a shining team-leading 22 points and 11 rebounds from Tyrone Watson. Stefon Barrett and Joey Haywood added 19 and 15 rebounds, respectively, while Kevin Young achieved 12 points and 5 assists.</p> <p>On Saturday night, the Rainmen traveled to Prince Edward Island to take on the Storm in a battle of the top two teams in the NBL's Atlantic Division. Even with Stefon Barrett tallying 30 points and 8 rebounds, the Rainmen took a bad loss 116-100. Joey Haywood added 18 points, while Tim Parham (11) and Christopher Cayole (10) were the only other Rainmen to score in double figures.</p>

Rashad Whack led the way with 17 points for the Storm; while Brandon Robinson had a double-double of 15 points and 13 assists.</p> <p>The Storm continued 2015 the way they ended 2014, with another victory – in this case, a 116-100 victory over the Halifax Rainmen. Rashad Whack was the top scorer for the Storm, as he tallied 19 points; Nick Okorie and Brandon Robinson popped 18 points apiece. Nick Evans was one rebound short of a double-double (10 points, 9 boards).</p> <p>The Storm picked up their third win of the week by totally dominating the Moncton Miracles, 108-83, on the strength of finishing the game with a 23-8 fourth-quarter run. The top scorer for the Island was Nick Okorie, who tallied 27 points, 6 assists, four steals and a blocked shot. Their 103-96 victory Thursday night against the Brampton A's helped the Express's cause. Windsor was aided with 23 points from Tony Bennett, 19 points and 6 assists from Gary Gibson, and a 19-point, 10-rebound night from Quinnel Brown.

But on Saturday night, the Express lost a crucial battle with their division rivals, the London Lightning, as Windsor tumbled 107-85. Quinnel Brown and Jamarcus Ellis both scored 15 points apiece, while Tony Bennett added 14 and Kirk Williams Jr tallied twelve. Brown also led the team in rebounds, with nine boards.

NBL CANADA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

The National Basketball League of Canada is pleased to announce that Kenny Jones of the Saint John Mill Rats has been named Player of the Week for the week ending January 4, 2015. This is the first time this season that a member of the Mill Rats has earned this honour.

Jones, a 6'6" 215-pound power forward who played collegiately at Kentucky State, averaged 21.6 points per game in three contests this week, helping Saint John go 2-1 during that period. He also scored 40 points in the Mill Rats' 129-111 New Year's Day victory over Moncton.

This is the second time in Jones' career that he has claimed the Player of the Week honour; he previously won it for the week ending March 17, 2013.
