Win a few, lose a few, and right now the A's are on a winning streak with a 110-105 Tuesday night road victory against the Mississauga Power. Tyshwan Edmondson came off the bench to score 28 points; while Akeem Ellis finished with a double-double of 18 points and 10 rebounds. Thomas Granado also pulled down 10 boards, and garnered a double-double with 13 points.</p> <p>Unfortunately for the A's, their winning streak ended on the road Thursday night at Windsor, losing to the Express 104-90. Brent Jennings was the top point-earner for the A's with 22 and 10 rebounds; only Akeem Ellis (11), Anthony Harris (11) and Tyshwan Edmondson (10) scored in double figures for Brampton that night.</p> <p>The A's took their frustrations out on the visiting Halifax Rainmen, as Tyshwan Edmondson's 19 bench points helped Brampton secure a 102-92 victory. Besides Edmondson's points, Thomas Granado added a double-double of 18 points and 11 rebounds. Akeem Scott and Brent Jennings both had 17 points, while Scott also dished out nine assists.</p>

But the Rainmen's losing streak continued to four games, as they fell 102-92 on Friday night to the Brampton A's. Tyrone Watson hit 17 points to lead his team in scoring; only Stefon Barrett (14) and Joey Haywood (13) scored in double figures for the Rainmen. Kevin Young had a 9-9 game – nine rebounds and nine points.</p> <p>In 2012, London and Halifax battled each other for the NBL championship. The series went the full best-of-five games, with London emerging victorious. On Saturday night, these two teams met again, and this time four quarters couldn't determine a winner – but in overtime, Halifax emerged victorious 111-107, with Seiya Ando gaining 20 points to lead his teammates. Forrest Fisher and Joey Haywood added 18 and 17, respectively.</p>

With Brandon Robinson scoring 28 points and 11 rebounds, the Storm eked out a 103-100 road win against the Saint John Mill Rats on Thursday night. Nick Okorie and Billy Rush tallied 17 and 14 points, respectively.</p> <p>On Sunday, the Storm took their division-leading 13th victory by taking apart the Island Storm 109-103, on the strength of 25 points and 7 rebounds from Michael Martin, 22 points and 8 rebounds from Nick Evans, and four team-leading steals from Olu Famutimi.</p>

Newly-acquired Jabs Newby came off the bench to score 27 points; while Travis Releford basked in 17 points, 12 rebounds, six assists and three steals.</p> <p>If there was a silver lining in the Power's 100-94 loss to the Moncton Miracles, it was the arrival of Mississauga's newest player, Chad Posthumus. Posthumus scored 34 points and pulled down 22 rebounds in the loss; both totals were game highs for Mississauga. Marcus Capers and Warren Ward added 18 and 17 points, respectively.</p> <p>On Sunday afternoon, the Power continued to try to get that elusive win; ut even with 44 points from Omar Strong and a 20-point, 13-rebound night from Chad Posthumus, the Power were dimmed 109-103. Warren Ward (14) and Paul Cooper (12) were the only other players to score in double figures for Mississauga. Omar Strong's 11 3-pointers set a new all-time single-game NBL Canada record.</p>

NBL CANADA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

The National Basketball League of Canada is pleased to announce that Quinnel Brown of the Windsor Express has been named Player of the Week for the week ending January 11, 2015. The National Basketball League of Canada has confirmed the following playoff format for the 2014-15 NBL season. The magic number listed will count down to clinching the regular season division lead. When the magic number reaches zero, the team in first place has mathematically clinched the division title.

In the NBL quarterfinals, teams #1-#4 and teams #2-#3 will play each other in a best-of-five series, with a 2-2-1 format. The higher seed will have home court for games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 5.

In the NBL semifinals, the divisional teams will face each other in a best-of-seven series, with a 2-2-1-1-1 format. The higher seed will host games 1, 2, and (if necessary) 5 and 7.

The remaining team in each division will play each other in the NBL Finals, which will be a best-of-seven series with a 2-3-2 format. The team with the higher regular season winning percentage will receive home court advantage for Games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 6 and 7. The winner of that series will be named National Basketball League of Canada Playoff Champion and receive a championship trophy commemorating their victory.

In the event that two or more teams are tied in terms of playoff seeding, the following tiebreakers will take place, in order of importance:

- (1) head-to-head record shall determine the winner;
- (2) if still a tie, head-to-head record against common opponents will determine the winner;
- (3) if still a tie, points scored in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (4) if still a tie, average margin of victory in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (5) if still a tie, the team correctly calling the flip of a coin will be seeded higher.

Playoff format subject to change due to venue availability.
