Thomas Granado finished the night with three blocked shots for the A's.</p> <p>Next up for the A's were the London Lightning, and the chance for Brampton's newly-acquired Zane Johnson to face off against his old squad. But in Brampton's 112-107 Friday night loss, Zane Johnson's 5 points didn't even make him the highest-scoring "Johnson" on the A's (Kyle Johnson 18, Cavell Johnson 9). ## WINDSOR-THE ISLAND HEAD-TO-HEAD

The Island leads Windsor 1-0, winning by 3 points (one game to play)

2, and (if necessary) 5 and 7.

The remaining team in each division will play each other in the NBL Finals, which will be a best-of-seven series with a 2-3-2 format. The team with the higher regular season winning percentage will receive home court advantage for Games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 6 and 7. The winner of that series will be named National Basketball League of Canada Playoff Champion and receive a championship trophy commemorating their victory.

In the event that two or more teams are tied in terms of playoff seeding, the following tiebreakers will take place, in order of importance:

- (1) head-to-head record shall determine the winner;
- (2) if still a tie, head-to-head record against common opponents will determine the winner;
- (3) if still a tie, points scored in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (4) if still a tie, average margin of victory in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (5) if still a tie, the team correctly calling the flip of a coin will be seeded higher.

Playoff format subject to change due to venue availability.

The National Basketball League of Canada has confirmed the following playoff format for the 2014-15 NBL season. The magic number listed will count down to clinching the regular season division lead. When the magic number reaches zero, the team in first place has mathematically clinched the division title.

In the NBL quarterfinals, teams #1-#4 and teams #2-#3 will play each other in a best-of-five series, with a 2-2-1 format. The higher seed will have home court for games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 5.

In the NBL semifinals, the divisional teams will face each other in a best-of-seven series, with a 2-2-1-1-1 format. The higher seed will host games 1,
