Brampton ON L6W 4T2 Phone: (519) 943-0781 Fax: (519) 940-3730 Head Coach: David Magley Home Arena: Powerade Centre bramptonas.ca</p>	<p>With only two weeks left in the regular season, the Brampton A's surged past the London Lightning on Thursday night 110-102, on the strength of 19 points from Tyshwan Edmondson and double-figure scoring by three of their Johnsons – Zane (15), Kyle (14) and Bryson (10). Kyle Johnson also had nine rebounds. The win propelled the A's to the #2 seed and a plus-.500 record.</p> <p>The A's continued their winning ways late in the season, as Tyshwan Edmondson's 21 points helped give the Brampton crew a 99-91 triumph over the Windsor Express on Saturday night. Kyle Johnson added 18 points, while Cavell Johnson and Akeem Scott both scored 12 points for Brampton.</p>

But the Bluenose crew have rattled off a winning streak, punctuated with a 110-101 victory over the London Lightning on Monday afternoon. The newly-acquired Jermaine Dailey led the Rainmen in scoring with 19 points; Joey Haywood had 18 points, including going 8-for-11 from the line.</p> <p>For the Rainmen to claim the division title, they need, among other things, to win out against the Island Storm. On Thursday night, with 18 points from Forrest Fisher, 17 points from Seiya Ando and a 14-point, 10-rebound night from Kevin Young, the Rainmen claimed a 110-107 triumph over the Storm.</p> <p>In a game that was rescheduled for Saturday morning due to a snowstorm, the Rainmen made short work of the Mississauga Power with a 118-99 victory. The win was punctuated with 27 points from Kevin Young and 21 points from Liam McMorrow; Jermaine Dailey had a double-double of 15 points and 11 rebounds.</p> <p>On Sunday afternoon, the Rainmen claimed their ninth consecutive win, as they dispatched the Moncton Miracles at the Scotiabank Centre 113-97. The win was achieved with the help of Liam McMorrow, who achieved a double-double of 24 points and 16 rebounds. Kevin Young added 23 points in the Moncton win.</p>

All it would take for the Storm was one more win. But it was not to be, as the Island dried up 110-107 to Halifax, despite 27 points from Nick Okorie. Michael Martin had 15 points, while Nick Evans achieved a double-double of 11 rebounds and 10 points.</p> <p>The Storm lost yet another match on Sunday afternoon, this time a home contest against the Saint John Mill Rats 115-99. In the loss, Nick Evans was the top scorer for the Storm with 24 points and 8 rebounds; but Nick Okorie (14 pts) and Billy Rush (12 pts) were the only other Storm players to score in double figures.</p>

Unfortunately, weather delays forced the game to be rescheduled for Monday afternoon. But even with 36 points from Brent Jennings, the Lightning's winning streak was curbed 110-101. Jennings went 14-for-20 from the floor and 6-for-7 from the free throw line. Al Stewart (13) and Emmanuel Little (12) were the only other Lightning players to score in double figures.</p> <p>The Lightning returned home to face the Brampton A's in a battle for home-court advantage in the first round of the NBL's Central Division playoffs. But even with a double-double (18 pts, 11 rebs) from Marvin Phillips, and 15 points each from Emmanuel Little and Sefton Barrett, the Lightning lost 110-102 at home to Brampton. The loss pushed London to the #3 seed in the division with only a few games left on the calendar.</p>

Strong went 11-for-21 from the floor, but that also included going 10-for-18 from beyond 3-point range. Paul Cooper led the Power in rebounds, with 13 boards.</p> <p>Omar Strong had another strong night as the Power went on the road Thursday evening against the Saint John Mill Rats. In the Power's 119-117 loss, Strong finished with 35 points and 8 assists. Jason Weidner had a 20-point, 7-rebound night, while Marcus Capers led the Power in rebounding, with 9 pull-downs.</p> <p>The road trip continued into Saturday afternoon, but neither Malcolm Grant's 28 points nor Marcus Capers' 24 tallies could put a win in the Power scoresheet, as Mississauga fell to 7-22 with a 118-99 loss to the Halifax Rainmen. Omar Strong was held to 15 points in the Mississauga defeat.</p>

Trayvon Lathan put together a double-double of 16 points and 14 team-high rebounds.</p>

But if they can keep winning, they may have a chance at the #2 ranking. And a 119-117 win at Harbour Station against the Mississauga Power may help to achieve that goal. In the win, Kenny Jones and Johnny Mayhane achieved 26 and 22 points, respectively; while Tyrone Levett and Keith Cothran came off the bench to tally 18 and 17 points.</p> <p>On Sunday, the Mill Rats took another victory, this time against the division-leading Island Storm 115-99 on the road. NUMBER ONE OVERALL SEED

WINDSOR EXPRESS claim overall #1 seed (point differential)

The National Basketball League of Canada has confirmed the following playoff format for the 2014-15 NBL season. The magic number listed will count down to clinching the regular season division lead. When the magic number reaches zero, the team in first place has mathematically clinched the division title.

In the NBL quarterfinals, teams #1-#4 and teams #2-#3 will play each other in a best-of-five series, with a 2-2-1 format. The higher seed will have home

court for games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 5.

In the NBL semifinals, the divisional teams will face each other in a best-of-seven series, with a 2-2-1-1-1 format. The higher seed will host games 1, 2, and (if necessary) 5 and 7.

The remaining team in each division will play each other in the NBL Finals, which will be a best-of-seven series with a 2-3-2 format. The team with the higher regular season winning percentage will receive home court advantage for Games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 6 and 7. The winner of that series will be named National Basketball League of Canada Playoff Champion and receive a championship trophy commemorating their victory.

In the event that two or more teams are tied in terms of playoff seeding, the following tiebreakers will take place, in order of importance:

- (1) head-to-head record shall determine the winner;
- (2) if still a tie, head-to-head record against common opponents will determine the winner;
- (3) if still a tie, points scored in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (4) if still a tie, average margin of victory in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (5) if still a tie, the team correctly calling the flip of a coin will be seeded higher.

Playoff format subject to change due to venue availability.
